

What do people think they can get away with doing in order to maximise their remuneration?


Leaders need to notice the current situation.

#### The recent Cole Inquiry into bribery and corruption

On 30 January 2006 *The Melbourne Age* newspaper reported:

"The commission of inquiry probing ... murky deals ... has revealed further details ... to show ... a culture of kickbacks."





Some never really accomplish anything.


I wanted to understand why.



### the Residue After writing a letter to a Sydney newspaper supporting critical mass, I read this reply:




# So Mat?

Each conversation has an impact on reality.


Cumulative impact.

Do you try to level off one leg – fold a piece of cardboard and stuff it under the shortest leg?


Align mood by adjusting one of the four components.




